Los Angeles, California - November 6, 2008. Each year, the Tuskegee Airmen Scholarship Foundation grants scholarship awards to deserving young men and women. Forty awards of \$1,500.00 will be available in 2009. Applicants must be students of accredited high schools who have graduated or will graduate in the school year 2008-2009. Applying students must have a GPA of at least three points (3.0) on a four-point scale. Additionally, one \$20,000.00 Pratt & Whitney award is presented to a scholar who demonstrates a sincere aptitude for and pursuit of a career in aviation, aerospace technology or research. This four-year Award is paid in increments of \$5,000 per year.
